

WordPress Integration Guidelines

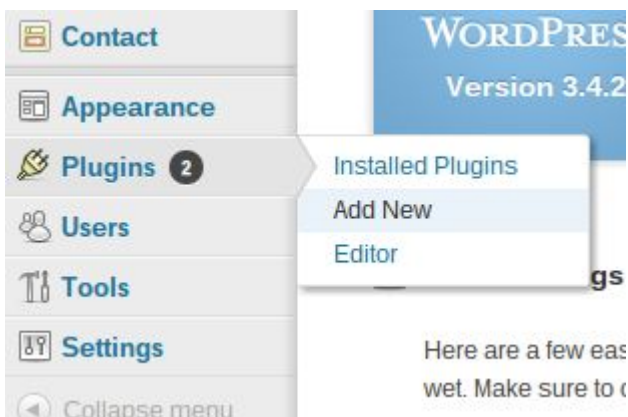
Step 1.

Log in to your WordPress account via yoursite.com/wp-admin using your credentials.



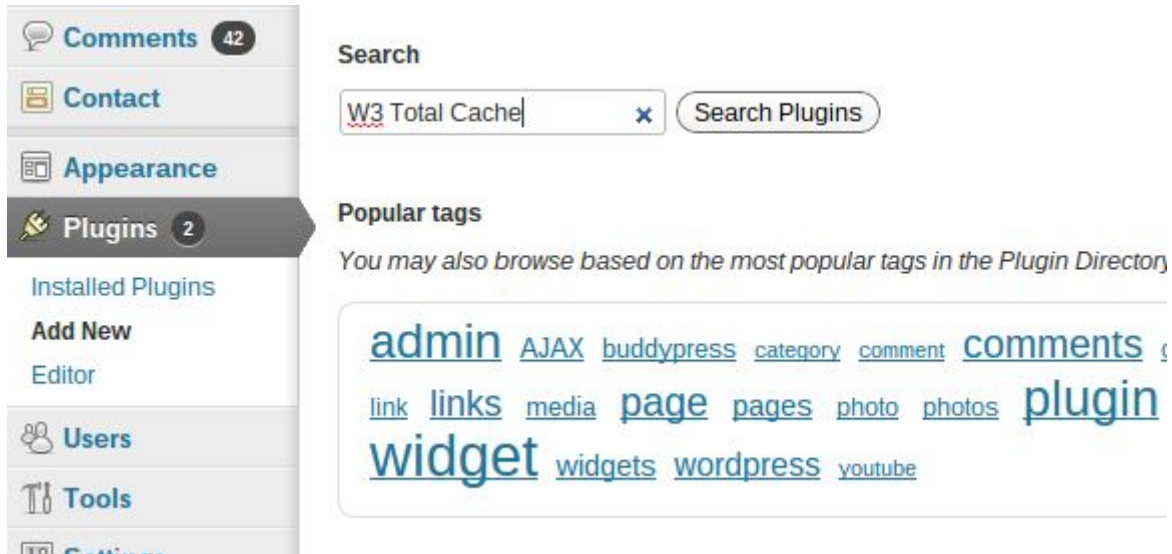
Step 2.

Click on 'Add New' in the 'Plugins' menu.



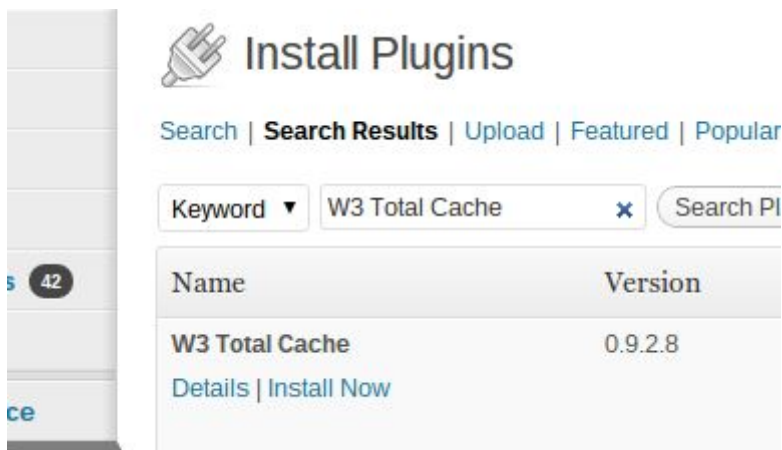
Step 3.

Find W3 Total Cache using search.



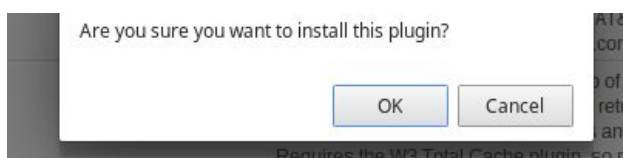
Step 4.

Install W3 Total Cache.



Step 5.

Confirm installation.



Step 6.

Click on 'Activate Plugin'.



Step 7.

Choose the 'Performance' option from the 'Plugins' menu.



Step 8.

Enable CDN checking the 'Enable' checkbox under 'General Settings' in your Dashboard.

CDN

Host static files with your content delivery network provider to reduce page load time.

CDN: **Enable**
Theme files, media library attachments, CSS, JS files etc will appear to load instantly for site visitors.

CDN Type:
Select the CDN type you wish to use.

Click on 'Specify it here'.



Step 10.

Specify your CDNvideo domain name (you can find it in the email message with all settings that you received from our employee).
